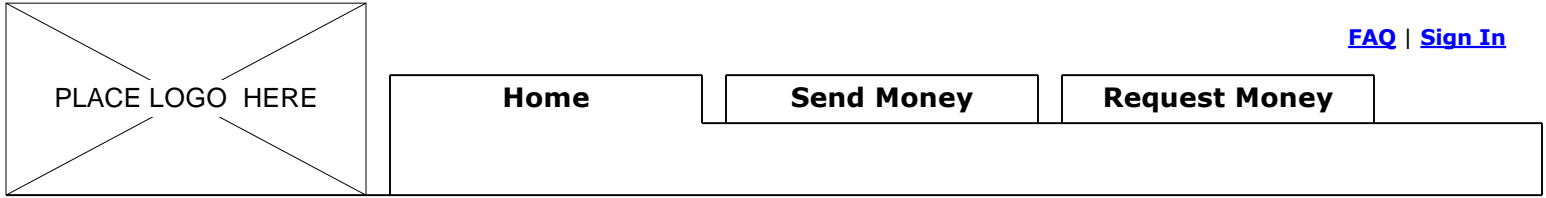

Not "Signed In":

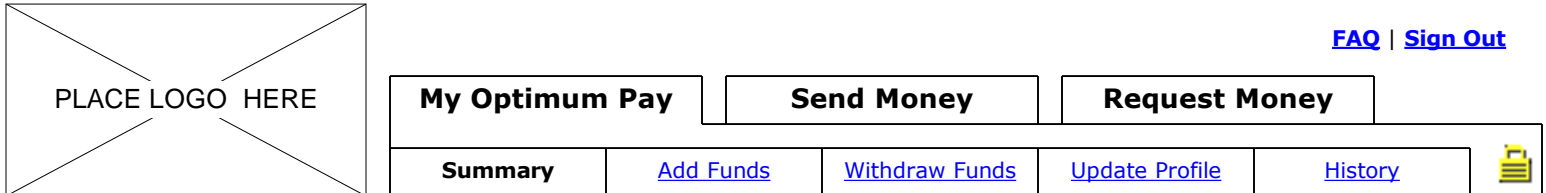

If they click on "Send Money" or "Request Money" they go to a page that has "Marketing speak" that explains the process and allows them to jump to "Sign Up". "Signed In" and within "My Optimum Pay"

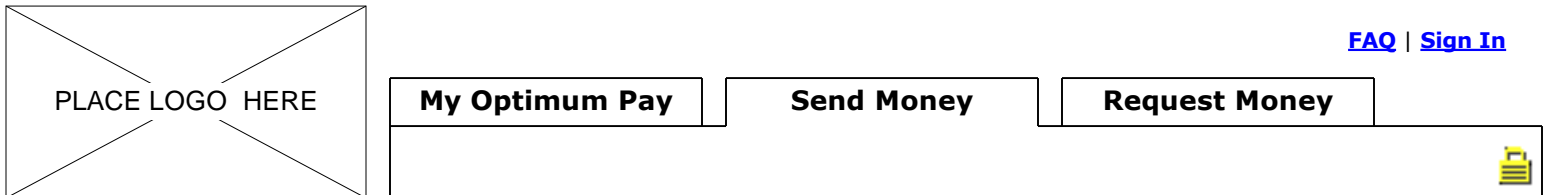

"Signed In" and stepping through a process
